The CCG needed to complete work which was underway with partners across the health economy in multi-agency discussions in relation to the provision of acute services. This work would utilise triangulation between finance, workforce and activity.</p> <p>The threshold required the CCG to progress strategic plans with partners regarding the local acute services review. This work progressed significantly since the 10-day window additional evidence review and included all relevant partners with oversight by the DH / NHS CB through regional and national teams.
